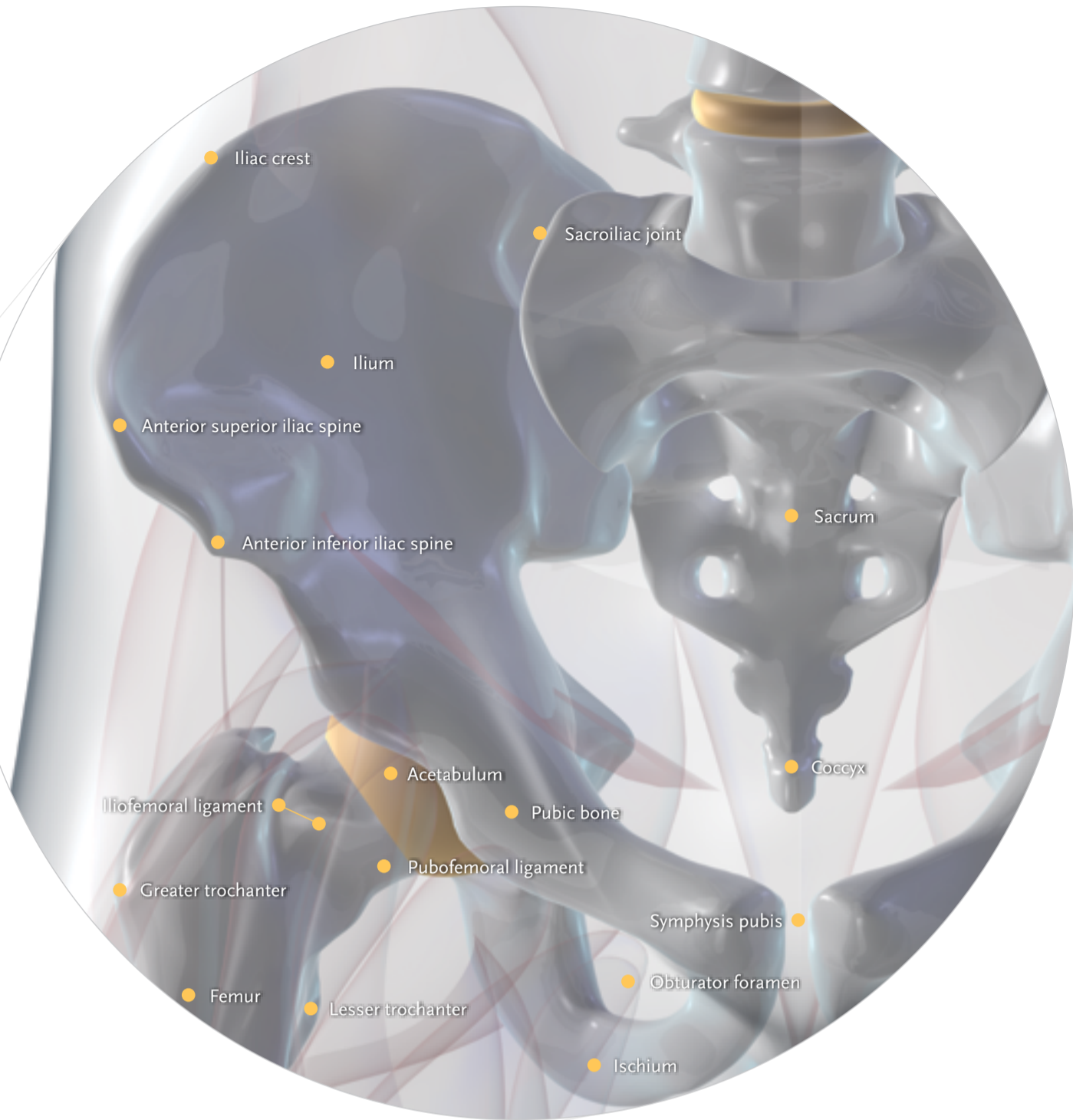
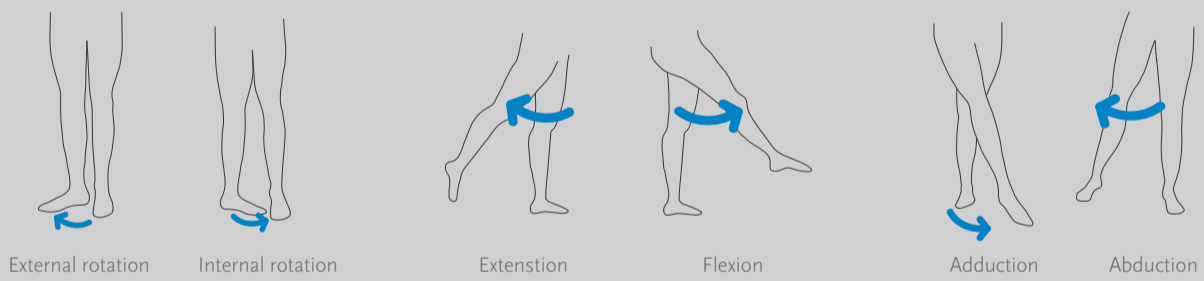

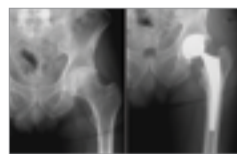
HIP - MOVEMENTS



HIP PATHOLOGIES/INJURIES



DISLOCATIONS
A hip dislocation occurs when the head of the femur slips out of its socket in the acetabulum



OSTEOARTHRITIS
Wear and tear of the cartilage in the hip joint with reactive changes in bone which may result in the need for hip replacement surgery.



HIP FRACTURES
A fracture to the upper part of the femur



LABRUM TEARS
Conditions benefitting from hip repositioning and/or compression around the greater trochanters, this may include hip osteoarthritis (OA) and Femoroacetabular impingement (FAI)
