







### SPINE - MOVEMENTS


#### Cervical spine



#### Thoraco-lumbar spine




### SPINAL PATHOLOGIES/INJURIES



**SPINAL FRACTURES**  
Fracture of one or multiple parts of a vertebrae, often due to trauma or secondary to disease, such as osteoporosis.



**HERNIATED DISC**  
Rupture or herniation of an intervertebral disc, often causing pain, weakness or numbness due to pressure on the spinal nerves.



**SPONDYLOSIS**  
Degeneration or narrowing of the disc spaces between the vertebrae, commonly associated with osteoarthritis.



**SPONDYLOLITHESIS**  
Anterior (forward) displacement of a vertebra, which usually occurs at L5/ S1.
