



The Use of an Unloader Brace to Improve Quality of Life for

an Active Transtibial Amputee

Steve is an active transtibial amputee and mental health support worker. He suffered a motorbike accident over 20 years ago which left him with a badly damaged and painful ankle. In late 2019, after undergoing one of many ankle surgeries, he acquired an infection which led to the decision to amputate his left leg below the knee.

Steve describes this as being a largely positive decision as he has much less pain and better quality of life post-amputation.

However, the years of loading up his 'good leg', combined with a naturally valgus knee posture has taken its toll and he now has painful lateral compartment osteoarthritis.


This was causing Steve 5/10 pain when walking and severely limited his fitness goals, ability to climb up and down stairs and go for long walks.



After discussions with his Orthotist, Steve began using an Unloader One SmartDosing brace from Össur. When using the brace he describes his pain as being "1 or 2/10" and experiences instant relief when wearing it. Watch Steve walking without a brace to compare with his gait with a brace to see the difference.

He describes these other positive attributes when wearing the brace:

- Improved stability
- Ability to walk stairs
- He can focus on walking correctly on his prosthetic side
- Improved sleep (less wake ups due to pain)
- Less medication use



Visual analysis of Steve's gait also shows smoother gait and slightly reduced knee valgus. This is all consistent with the evidence and what we would expect when seeing reduced load through the lateral compartment of the knee. To paraphrase Steve, "it's not too much to describe it as life changing. It encourages me to walk more. Because I now can. (I have) almost no pain when

walking with the brace. (Walking) is almost painless, it makes such a difference." With great thanks to Steve for allowing us to use his story and to the team at Custom Prosthetics & BraceFit QLD for putting us in touch.


Sam's key message is: "Be honest & truthful to what aligns with you, this is the key to a fulfilled life."
